for Continued Accreditation***

SUMMARY AND REQUEST FOR CONTINUED ACCREDITATION

Through the self-study process and in this report of that process, John A. Logan College has demonstrated that it continues to meet the Commission's Criteria for Accreditation, including the General Institutional Requirements and the Evaluative Criteria. Although the Self-Study process has revealed areas to be addressed as opportunities for continuous improvement, the College has clearly demonstrated its ability to analyze and improve its operations and activities in order to maintain institutional stability and achieve appropriate institutional growth.

Evidence that the General Institutional Requirements are met is provided in Chapter Two. Through an investigation of each of the Evaluative Criteria in Chapters Three through Seven, strong evidence has been provided that all of the College's purposes are clear, appropriate, and publicly stated; that the College has effectively organized adequate human, financial, and physical resources into educational and other programs to accomplish all of its purposes; that the College is indeed accomplishing its purposes as expressed in its mission statement; that the College can continue to accomplish its purposes; and that the College demonstrates integrity in its practices and relationships.

Therefore, John A. Logan College requests continued accreditation for a ten-year period from the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.
