COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Command and the WMD Response Course is a one-day training course that prepares the management-level responder to serve as a member of an incident management team. The course offers instruction on incident management considerations and provides the responder with the ability to develop a local Incident Action Plan (IAP) to a CBRNE incident. The course culminates with the responder participating in scenario-driven responses to various CBRNE incidents.

Prerequisite(s): To be eligible to attend the Command and the WMD Response Course, candidates must have successfully completed awareness training for CBRNE response and the IS-700 course offered by the Emergency Management Institute (EMI) of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Target Audience/Disciplines: Law Enforcement, Emergency Medical Services, Emergency Management Agency, Fire Service, Hazardous Material, Public Works, Governmental Administrative, Public Safety Communications, Health Care, and Public Health.
