Here are the Big Ideas presented in ***Developmentally Appropriate Practice and Intentionality*** and ***Developmentally Appropriate Practice and Play***. The programs are designed as self-paced, interactive learning opportunities that can be used by individuals as a self-study resource. The videos also feature classroom scenes depicting intentionality in action and play in programs for infants, toddlers, preschoolers, kindergartners, and primary grade children; and voices of experts: teachers, administrators, researchers, and others.

For each topic, the learner will:

- Watch a video that focuses on an element of the topic (intentionality / play)
- Have opportunities to reflect on the concepts presented and extend your learning
- Download and print resources to further extend your learning about DAP
- View Web seminars based on your role: Teacher and Family Child Care Provider; Faculty and Trainers; Early Childhood Program Administrator
- Participate in discussions with your colleagues through online community forums
