Only MAT 116 is required, BUS 110 is recommended. Students should select one course from ANT 111, ANT 216, GEO 112, HIS 103, HIS 104, HUM 120, PHL 200, PHL 260, PSC 120, or PSC 212 to satisfy the Global Studies requirement for all majors.

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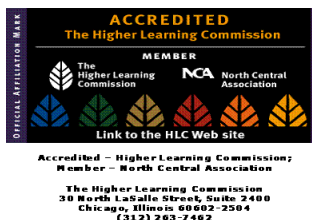
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
