Consult with the transfer institution to assess if certain courses require a grade of "C" or higher, or if there is a minimum grade point average for admission to your declared major. Please select courses on this guide in accordance with the Articulation Notes for your transfer institution.

SIUC TRANSFER INFORMATION: Students interested in Business Economics should follow the guide established for an A.A. degree in Business. This guide prepares one to pursue the BA in Economics in the College of Liberal Arts. SIUC policy now allows for the transfer and acceptance of up to 78 articulated semester credits applicable toward degree requirements. For this program, that is 14 credits beyond the requirements for this AA degree.

Take ECO 201 (ECON 241), ECO 202 (ECON 240). Complete a two course sequence in a foreign language (FRE 101/102, GER 101/102, SPN 101/102). IPP 141/142 will also satisfy the foreign language requirement. Select two courses from the following to satisfy an International course requirement for a BA under the College of Liberal Arts. ART 220 (AD 207A), ART 223 (AD 207C), ANT 111 or 216 (ANTH 104), GEO 112 (GEOG 103), HIS 103 (HIST 101A), HIS104 (HIST 101B), HIS 112 (HIST 112), PSC 289 (POLS 250), PSC 213 (POLS 270) or SOC 263 (SOC 304i). Take BUS 121 (ECON 308) which satisfies the COLA "Writing Across - the - Curriculum" requirement.

Take ENG 101 (ENGL 101), 102 (ENGL 102) and 113 (ENGL 291). ENG 113 (ENGL 291) will then satisfy the College of Liberal Arts writing course requirement beyond ENGL 101 and 102.

The Economics degree offers four different specializations (General, Financial Economics, International Economics and Law and Economics). Take BUS 121 (ECON 308) a required Foundation course in each specialization. Courses to consider within each specialization include,

*FINANCIAL ECONOMICS: ACC 200/201 (ACCT 220), BUS 121 (MGMT 208), BUS 235 (MGMT 202), CIS 207 (CS 200B), CPS 206 (CS 202), CPS 215 (CS 220), PSY 200 (PSYC 307) and SOC 215 (SOC 215)

* INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS: HIS 112 (HIST 112), LIT 284 (ENGL 205), PHL 111 (PHIL 104) and PHL 121 (PHIL 105).

* LAW and ECONOMICS: CRJ 102 (CCJ 201), CRJ 105 (CCJ 290), CRJ 209 (PARL 315 or CCJ 310), HIS 112 (HIST 112), PHL 111 (PHIL 104), PHL 121 PHIL 105),PSC 220 (POLS 230) and PSC 289 (POLS 250).

SIUE Transfer Information

Take 202 (ECON 112), ECO 201 (ECON 111), MAT 117 or 131 (MS 250) and BUS 121 (MS 251). With an AA degree, the following are only recommended: MAT 108 (MATH 120, MAT 113 (QR 101) or MAT 131 (MATH 150), PHL 121 (RA 101). The BA degree requires two semesters of the same foreign language (FRE 101/102, GER 101/102, SPN 101/102 or IPP 141/142). In addition, 8 courses in the fine arts or humanities. With the 3 courses in the IAI Humanities and Fine Arts and the two in Foreign Language, three additional courses should be selected from the IAI Humanities Elective and/or Fine Arts Electives areas.

ISU Transfer Information

Take ECO 201 and 202 (ECO 105), MAT 120 or 282 (ECO 138). Note BUS 121 (MQM 100) will substitute for the ECO 138 requirement. Take MAT 117 (MAT 121) or MAT 131 (MAT 145). Students pursuing the BA option will need to complete a foreign language through the third semester (FRE 101/102/201, GER 101/102/201 or SPN 101/102/201). Students pursuing the BS option will need to complete a 3 credit SMT course selected from BIO 226, 240, 275, CHM 142, 152, 201, MAT 120 or 282, MAT 117, 201, 202, 221, PHS 107, BUS 121, PHY 156, 206. All graduates must complete a course designated to fulfill the AMALI requirement selected from GEO 112, PSC 120, 212, ANT 111, 216, HIS 103, 104, 213, HUM 120, PHL 200, 260, PSC 213.

EIU Transfer Information

Take ECO 201 (ECN 2810G) OR ECO 201 (ECN2802G), take MAT 131 (MAT 1441G) or MAT 117 (MAT 2110G) and MAT 116 (MAT 2120G) or MAT 221 (MAT 2550G)

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
