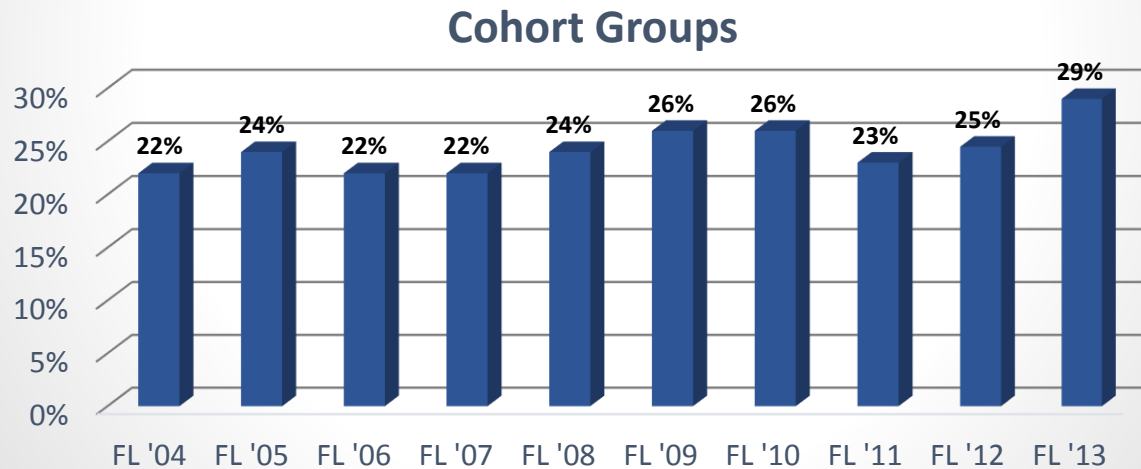


Graduation Rates

The overall graduation rate is also known as the "Student Right-to-Know" or IPEDS graduation rate. It tracks the progress of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree- or certificate-seeking students to determine if they complete a degree or other award such as a certificate within 150% of "normal time" for completing the program in which they enrolled.*

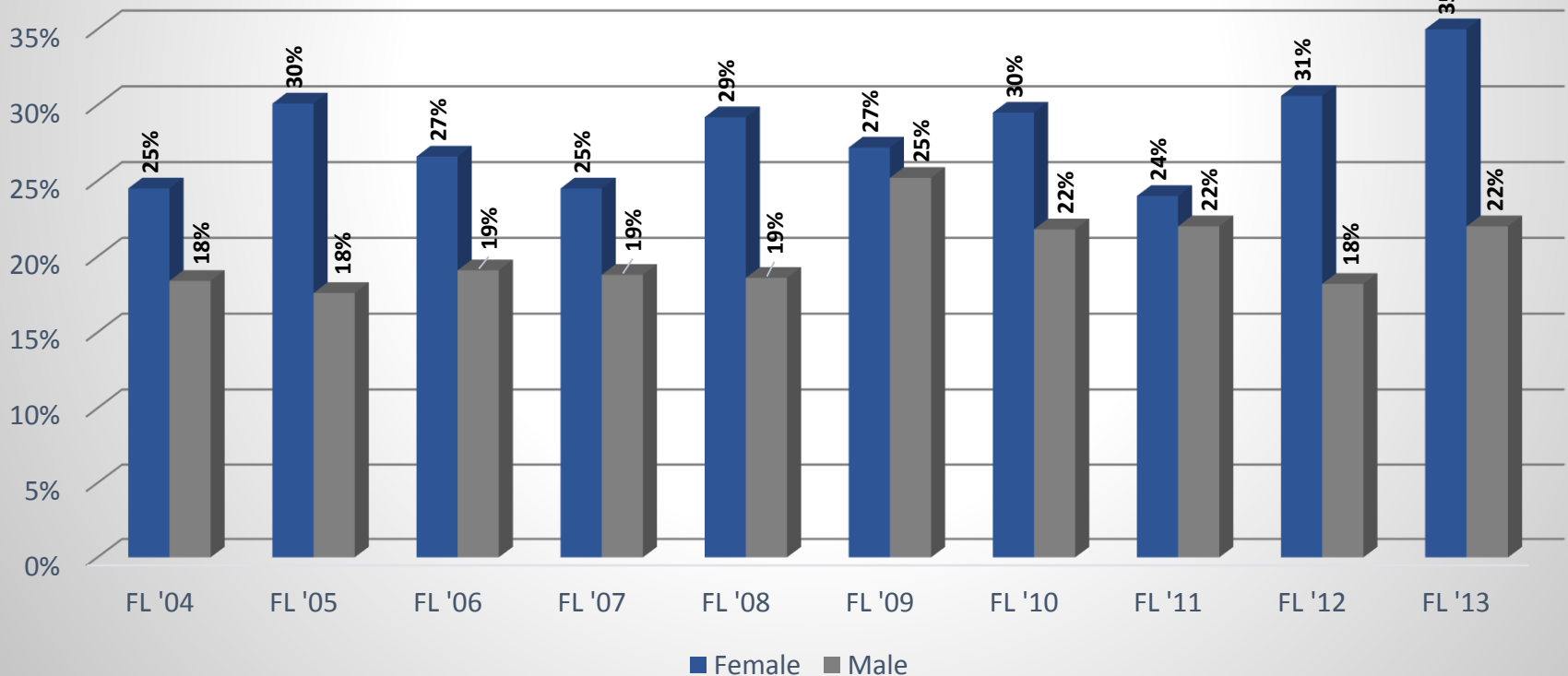


*Please note that not all students at the institution are tracked for these rates. Students who have already attended another postsecondary institution, or who began their studies on a part-time basis are not tracked for this rate. At John A. Logan College, 15 percent of entering students were counted as "full-time, first-time" in 2015.
