Carbondale Branch AAUW Scholarships

The Carbondale Branch of the American Association of University Women (AAUW) is offering three educational scholarships for the purpose of promoting scholarship and educational advancement for women. The awards will be applied to the Bursar account for the school year beginning July 1, 2010. Preference for these awards will be given to students from the local area.

Graduate Scholarships

One scholarship (\$500) will be awarded to a woman currently enrolled at Southern Illinois University Carbondale (SIUC) AND continuing or entering any field of graduate education in the Graduate School or a program of professional education in law or medicine.

The Joyce A. Kelly Memorial Scholarship (\$500) is reserved for a current, non-traditional, female SIUC student. The late Joyce A. Kelly achieved her educational goals late in life while, as a single mother, raising her family. Her family and friends established the scholarship in her memory to commemorate her achievements and her dedication to AAUW.

Undergraduate Scholarship

The Lelia Marvin AAUW Scholarship (\$500) will be awarded to a female John A. Logan College student completing an associate degree and enrolling in SIUC in Fall '10.

To apply, students must submit a letter which includes information on their current and planned enrollment status, major, scholastic and other achievements, financial status relating to attending school, Dawg tag number, three contact references, and a statement of professional goals. Attach a current resume and latest transcript.
