Orientation (ORI)

ORI 100 College 101

1 Hour

Prerequisites: None

2 hours weekly (1-0)

This course is designed to help students in their transition to college. Students will learn about the resources and services available at John A. Logan College, as well as the expectations of being a college student.

ORI 111 PN Orientation

.5 Hours

Prerequisites: Admission to LPN program

.5 hours weekly (.5-0)

This course introduces the student to the concepts and requirements of the License Practical Nursing Program. Students will learn the expectations of both John A. Logan College and the Nursing Department. Topics discussed include the John A. Logan College mission and values, the social media policy, HIPPA violations, course, lab and clinical requirements, ATI testing procedure, criminal background checks and drug screening.

ORI 212 ADN Orientation

.5 Hours

Prerequisites: Admission to ADN program

.5 hours weekly (.5-0)

This course will introduce students to the ADN program entry requirements for classroom, labs, and clinicals.
