1.) Higher Reach (HiR) software has been in operation as of the August 11th, 2014.

2.) Having a valid *email account* is required!

- The HiR system requires students and instructors to have valid email addresses.
- HiR automatically sends registration confirmations, payment invoice, and a thank you for registering email upon enrollment.

3.) Instructor Duties

Online Registration Assistance

• All instructors who have internet access in their class rooms are asked to show their students the online HiR registration process. This will be a guided learning instructional benefit for students to navigate the system for future classes.

Higher Reach Login and Instructor Resources

- Higher Reach generates a login and Invites you to create Password via email. Website: www.jalc.edu, View Community Courses, Community Education, Classes and Registration. *See in upper right corner the Student and Instructor Login options. Instructors should have received a login Invitation to set up their HiR Login. Check your email Inbox for an email from Higher Reach. If you did not receive an Invite, contact kimneace@jalc.edu and I can re-send to you. Very important to get this done before registrations begin!
- All instructors will check their own attendance and can email their students.

 Course rosters can be printed by instructors from their HiR Instructor accounts.


 Attendance Records

4.) Student Registrations and Payments


