

**Articulation Agreement
Between
McKendree University and John A. Logan College
AA to BSED – Elementary Education**

This articulation agreement is the result of discussions between McKendree University and John A. Logan College. McKendree and John A. Logan agree that both institutions value this cooperative agreement and that this agreement will best serve the current students of both institutions.

Terms and Conditions

Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

McKendree and John A. Logan have developed a four-year program plan to facilitate the most seamless transfer possible for John A. Logan students who complete the Associate in Arts Degree (AA) at John A. Logan and desire to earn the Bachelor of Science in Education Degree in Elementary Education at McKendree University.

Students who satisfactorily complete the AA requirements with John A. Logan will be admitted to McKendree University.

McKendree and John A. Logan agree to inform potential transfer students of the existence of this institutional articulation agreement and the advantages of pursuing the articulated programs.

Section II: Transfer of credit

McKendree University agrees to accept a maximum of 90 semester hours of credit from the John A. Logan graduate who seeks to complete a baccalaureate degree at McKendree. McKendree University will communicate specific options for students and give careful consideration to all previously completed courses. Courses in addition to those used to earn the AA at John A. Logan will be evaluated individually to determine which are transferable and what requirements have been met. Completion of the AA fulfills all general education requirements with McKendree University.

Section III: Program Plan

The four-year program plan for the BSED in Elementary Education is included at the end of this agreement. These plans will specify the student degree course plan and transfer credit requirements.

Degree course plans will be reviewed by both McKendree University and John A. Logan representatives on an annual basis, and revised or updated as needed to reflect any changes in the degree requirements.

Terms of the Agreement


This agreement becomes effective on August 1, 2021 and remains in effect until July 31, 2025, unless changed in writing by mutual agreement of McKendree University and John A. Logan College. The agreement can be amended at any time with the approval of both institutions. Should either institution desire to discontinue this agreement, written advance notification of 60 days will be required. Termination, however, will not be executed without a negotiated teach-out agreement for students currently enrolled.

Both institutions hereby indicate full agreement to the terms and conditions included above and the honoring of the course, program, and other requirements outlined in the four-year program plan attached at the end of this agreement.





- Have a cumulative transfer GPA of no less than 2.75
- Educational Technology course*
- Coursework marked with ** indicated specific content required for licensure

*Students transferring in who have completed all of the listed coursework will still need to take EDU 115 (McKendree), not available at John A Logan. Although a pre-requisite for the Teacher Education Program, this course can be taken by transfer students concurrently with the first semester of their junior year.
