## Information & Guidelines for Use of Mees Centre and the Harrison-Bruce Historical Village

The Harrison-Bruce Historical Village sits on the grounds of John A. Logan College, Carterville, Illinois. The village consists of the Harrison House, Dog Trot General Store, Purdy School, Hunter Cabin and the Robert L. Mees Centre. The Robert L Mees Centre serves as the hub of the Harrison-Bruce Historical Village by providing a venue for college and community events.

The beautiful venue accommodates up to 100 guests and rents for \$300 per day. Facility rental includes tables, chairs, one-time set-up, audio-visual equipment (as available), air conditioning, and general lighting.

Private or groups tours of the village buildings, led by our volunteer docents can be arranged ahead of time

If food is to be served, it must be prepared by an approved caterer on our JALC Approved Catering list.
