Dr. José D. Najar received his Ph.D. from Indiana University-Bloomington in 2012 and became an assistant professor at SIUC in 2014. He is a historian of 19th and 20th century Brazil and Latin America. His work focuses on topics of whiteness and non-European diasporas in the Americas, gender inequality, imperialism, anticolonial resistance, and nationalism. Before coming to Southern Illinois University at Carbondale, Dr. Najar taught world history at Indiana University/Purdue University at Columbus and Latina/o/x history in the department of Latino Studies at Indiana University, Bloomington.
