- Course additions: ACT program updated (12 new courses), SOC 220: Sociology of Gender, SOCW 280: Rural and Minority Populations, COM 140: Argumentation and Debate, COM 280: Communication Studies Practicum
- Switch from Speech Communication AA to Communication Studies AA
- SCI 100 added to 16 program guides in Life & Physical Science to be an option for ORI 100

The tally sheet and approval process was discussed. For an item to be placed on the agenda, at least 2/3 of the committee must agree on its necessity.
