### **STEPS TO COMPLETING A FINANCIAL AID FILE**

1. Complete your 2023-2024 FAFSA at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov). Tax information from 2021 is used to complete the 2023-24 FAFSA. Be sure to include John A. Logan College's federal school code, 008076, when completing the FAFSA.
2. John A. Logan College receives FAFSA information electronically. Upon receipt of the FAFSA data, a financial aid offer will be emailed to the student listing estimated awards and any required documents needed to complete a student's financial aid file. Required documents must be completed and returned to the Financial Aid Office for funds to be released.
3. An official high school transcript with a graduation date or GED transcript with a completion date must be on file in the Admissions Office.
4. Book vouchers are issued upon completion of your financial aid file.
5. Financial aid is disbursed with the expectation that all registered coursework will be completed. A portion of financial aid funds may need to be returned to the U.S. Department of Education if you completely withdraw from all of your courses.
6. Financial aid refunds will be issued if your financial aid funds exceed tuition and fees plus book voucher charges.

Please note: Financial Aid can only be received at one institution at a time per semester.
