PATH ASSISTANCE

Eligibility

- **Must be enrolled in a Nursing or Allied Health Program**
- **Must be in-district**
- **Low income (receiving federal aid, such as SNAP, Medicaid, or TANF)**
- **First generation college student**
- **Minority or underrepresented student population**
- **Incumbent worker**

Apply

To receive assistance from Path, you must first complete a Path application, meet with the Path Support Coordinator, and provide any additional information including: documentation verifying eligibility (Financial Aid award letter, PELL grant information), current class schedule, and current booklist or supply list.
