**How Articulation Agreement Works**

- The plan leads to a Bachelor of Arts degree in Agribusiness Management at Illinois College. Students will fill out applications for both schools and consult the advisors and catalogs from both schools for specifics. This completion guide is designed to ensure graduation in four years by taking courses full-time at both John A. Logan College and Illinois College. This guide assumes students have met all course prerequisites required by John A. Logan College and admission requirements for Illinois College.
- Upon completion of the first two years' requirements at John A. Logan College, students will receive an Associates in Applied Science degree (A.A.S) in Agribusiness Management.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 should be achieved for admission to Illinois College and a 2.0 GPA maintained to graduate as an Agribusiness Management major. Only courses with grades of C- or better will transfer to IC.
- Students transferring from an articulated A.A.S. program are guaranteed 60 credits in transfer with additional credits reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- Students will be required to complete all major requirements at Illinois College and any remaining general education and graduation requirements.
