APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 24, 2023

PRESENTATION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS

In October, the Decennial Committee voted to review all intergovernmental agreements with John A. Logan College presented in the report. President Overstreet added that this had been a good exercise to understand how the grant agreements positively impact our students and the community. Many governmental bodies and higher education institutions were exempt from this public act, and community colleges have since been considered exempt from the next cycle.

Trustee Little requested a motion to approve this information for the formal report to be submitted to the county.

Jake Rendleman and Magnus Noble moved and seconded that the report be formulated for consideration at the next meeting on March 26, 2024.

A voice vote showed all in favor. Motion carried.
