BOOK VOUCHER & REFUNDS BY COURSE

To receive federal, state or institutional aid (grants, student loans, or scholarships), students must complete their financial aid file.

REFUNDS for 16-WEEK, 1st 8-WEEK, & 4A-WEEK COURSES

- Classes Begin: Monday, January 12, 2026
- Book Voucher Ends*: Monday, February 24, 2026
- Aid Posted to Student Account: Monday, March 2, 2026
- Refunds Available: Week of March 9, 2026

REFUNDS for 12-WEEK & 4B-WEEK COURSES

- Classes Begin: Monday, February 9, 2026
- Book Voucher Ends*: Thursday, February 26, 2026
- Refunds Available: Week of March 9, 2026

REFUNDS for 2nd 8-WEEK & 4C-WEEK COURSES

- Classes Begin: Monday, March 16, 2026
- Book Voucher Ends*: Thursday, March 31, 2026
- Refunds Available: Week of April 6, 2026

REFUNDS for 4D-WEEK COURSES

- Classes Begin: Monday, April 13, 2026
- Book Voucher Ends*: Thursday, April 23, 2026
- Refunds Available: Week of April 20, 2026

*For students enrolled in courses of different durations (16, 8, and 4 weeks), the book voucher ends on the earliest posted date.

Payment Due Date: December 15, 2025

 Payment is required if financial aid does not cover your full balance. Payment plans are available via MyJALC.

You may only receive financial aid at one institution per semester.

Steps to Complete Your Financial Aid File

1 – Complete the 2025-26 FAFSA

- Submit at studentaid.gov
- Use 2023 tax information
- Include JALC's school code: 008076

2 - Check Your Email

- You will receive an estimated financial aid offer.
- Students selected for verification will be emailed the required documents to submit.

3 - Submit Transcripts

 Submit a high school transcript (with grad date) or GED transcript (with completion date) to the Admissions Office.

4 - Book Voucher Posted

 File must be complete, all required documents submitted, and remaining funds must be available after tuition and fees.

5 - Stay Enrolled & Receive Funds

- Aid is awarded with the expectation you will complete your coursework.
- If aid exceeds tuition, fees, and book charges, a REFUND will be issued.

NOTE:

Withdrawing from all classes before completing 60% of the term may result in owing money to the college.
