The International and Global Studies Bachelor of Arts can be taken as-is or there are two concentration options a student can choose from. The above route is the as-is/general IGS major path. The two concentrations are Diplomacy and International Relations & Global Affairs and Development. The course layout for all three options are the exact same except for the elective section (12-16 hours before ECCE Category). IGS students with no concentration may take elective courses from either/both concentrations (Diplomacy & International Relations and/or Global Affairs & Development) or other elective courses with an international or comparative focus with advisor's approval through a Student Petition. If a student chooses one of the concentration routes, they can only take courses from the groupings below to fulfill the 12-16 hour elective/concentration requirements.
