NOMINATING PETITIONS AVAILABLE FOR JOHN A. LOGAN COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Three six-year terms on the John A. Logan College Board of Trustees will be filled at the **April 6, 2027 Consolidated Election**. Candidates for Community College District Trustee are elected on a nonpartisan basis.

Nominating petition packets will be available beginning **August 25, 2026**, the first day petitions may be circulated for nonpartisan community college trustee candidates.

Petition packets may be obtained from the Assistant Director of Legislative Affairs, in the President's Office on the College's Carterville campus during regular business hours.

Candidates may file nominating petitions and required documents with the Assistant Director of Legislative Affairs, beginning **Monday, November 16, 2026**. Filing will be accepted from **8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday, November 16, through Friday, November 20, 2026**, and from **8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 23, 2026**, the final day of the filing period.

Candidates for the John A. Logan College Board of Trustees must be citizens of the United States, at least 18 years of age, residents of the State of Illinois, and residents of Community College District No. 530 for at least one year immediately preceding the election. Candidates are responsible for meeting all statutory qualifications and filing requirements prescribed by Illinois law.

Nomination papers generally include a Statement of Candidacy, nominating petition sheets containing the required number of signatures, and a receipt showing the filing of a Statement of Economic Interests.
